Since its first publication in 1922, the legal reference book *Clark on Surveying and Boundaries* has been a valuable source of information for judges, attorneys and surveyors. It has been referred to by various courts, from the U.S. Supreme Court to many local state courts in over 100 instances. This seminar will take a look at several of the various decisions referred to in the book and examine why the book is widely used and respected by both surveyors and the courts.



Instructor Walter G. Robillard, PLS, Esq. is a Professional Land Surveyor registered in Florida, Georgia, North Carolina and South Carolina. He is a member of the Georgia Bar. He has worked and taught continuing education courses internationally in the areas of real property, law, surveying and forestry. He is an honorary Member of the Florida Surveying and Mapping Society and a member of the numerous state societies. Mr. Robillard is a past president of the

American Congress on Surveying and Mapping and is the recipient of the Earl Fennell Award for Education. He was an original member of the Advisory Committee for the University of Florida Surveying program. Mr. Robillard is the co-author of the college textbooks Evidence and Procedures for Boundary Location, Boundary Control and Legal Principles and the legal reference book Clark on Surveying & Boundaries.
